To Bring

- Refillable Water Bottle (labeled with name) . . .it gets hot and hydration is important!!!!

What NOT to bring

- Electronics (ipods, CD or MP3 players, psp's, etc.)
- Phones
- Over the counter medication (Advil, Tylenol, Claritin, Sudafed, etc.) *These will be provided by the camp.*

Our ZERO TOLERANCE Policy

Bringing any of the following items to camp is cause for immediate dismissal. These items are under our ZERO TOLERANCE policy.

- Illegal Drugs
- Weapons of any kind
- Tobacco products
- Alcohol of any kind
- Impurity

Other Important Notes

- Each camper will be responsible for their own belongings. The camp is not responsible for lost or stolen items. **Label EVERYTHING!** Every pair of sock, book, shirt, etc
- **Registration does NOT begin until 1:30PM; we ask that you arrive at your staggered arrival time by region.**
- Campers are to remain in the camp during the entire program.
 - Any camper driving must check in their keys at registration. They will receive them back at the end of the program
 - Any parents who needs to take their teen off campus must sign them out with the camp administrator (please have this communicated with your regional staff before camp begins)
- **ONLY REGISTERED CAMPERS are allowed on the camp. No visitors are permitted. If you show up, you will be sent home.**

Care Packages

If you wish to send your camper a care package, it is encouraged that they are sent with a counselor or tribe leader for distribution at camp. Packages can also be dropped off at registration on Day 1 with your teen's check in. The University has asked us to limit the amount of mail coming into our conference since they do not check mail during the weekends. Thank you for understanding.
